Assessing conditions for learning and development and social and emotional (SE) competencies (i.e., knowledge, attitudes, and skills) is a complex task. It requires careful consideration of the assessment purpose, rigor, practicality, burden, and ethics. Once you have considered these factors and have determined that you are, in fact, *Ready to Assess*, you can move forward with choosing an assessment tool that will help achieve your desired purpose. This *Tools Index* is designed to help you make an informed decision on the best tool to assess conditions for learning and development and SE competencies.
